From the North (I-4)

Take Exit #55/US-27 and proceed south on US-27. Turn right onto Dundee Road/Hwy 542, VHA is 3 miles on the right.

From the South (Sebring/Avon Park)

Take US-27 North. Turn left onto Dundee Road/Hwy 542. VHA is 3 miles on the right.

From South Lakeland (Polk Parkway)

Take Exit #14/FL-540 east. Turn left onto US-17. Turn right onto Cypress Gardens Blvd. Turn left onto Overlook Drive. Turn left onto Carl Floyd Road. Turn left on Dundee Road. VHA is 0.2 miles on the right.

From North Lakeland / Auburndale (US 17-92)

Take 17-92 East. Turn right onto Havendale Blvd. Continue onto Avenue T. Continue onto Buckeye Loop Road. Turn left onto Dundee Road. VHA is 0.5 miles on the left.

What is Spiral CT?

CT, or Computed Tomography, works on the same physical principle as X-rays, with much greater detail and resolution. Spiral CT can image the brain, spinal cord, bones, chest and abdominal organs generating hundreds of digital images as the scanning tube rotates around the patient. A very powerful computer uses the gathered information to reconstruct a highly accurate, detailed internal image, creating a window to your pet's health. This information allows a quicker, more accurate diagnosis of many disease processes.

Complete Pain Management Protocols

Animals feel pain and have the same nerve pathways as we do. At VHA, prevention and treatment for pain is of utmost importance. All patients receive mandatory pain medications for any uncomfortable procedures. This may include pre-op sedatives, regional nerve blocks as with dental extractions, oral or injectable pain medications and even advanced continuous IV infusions for severe trauma or surgeries.



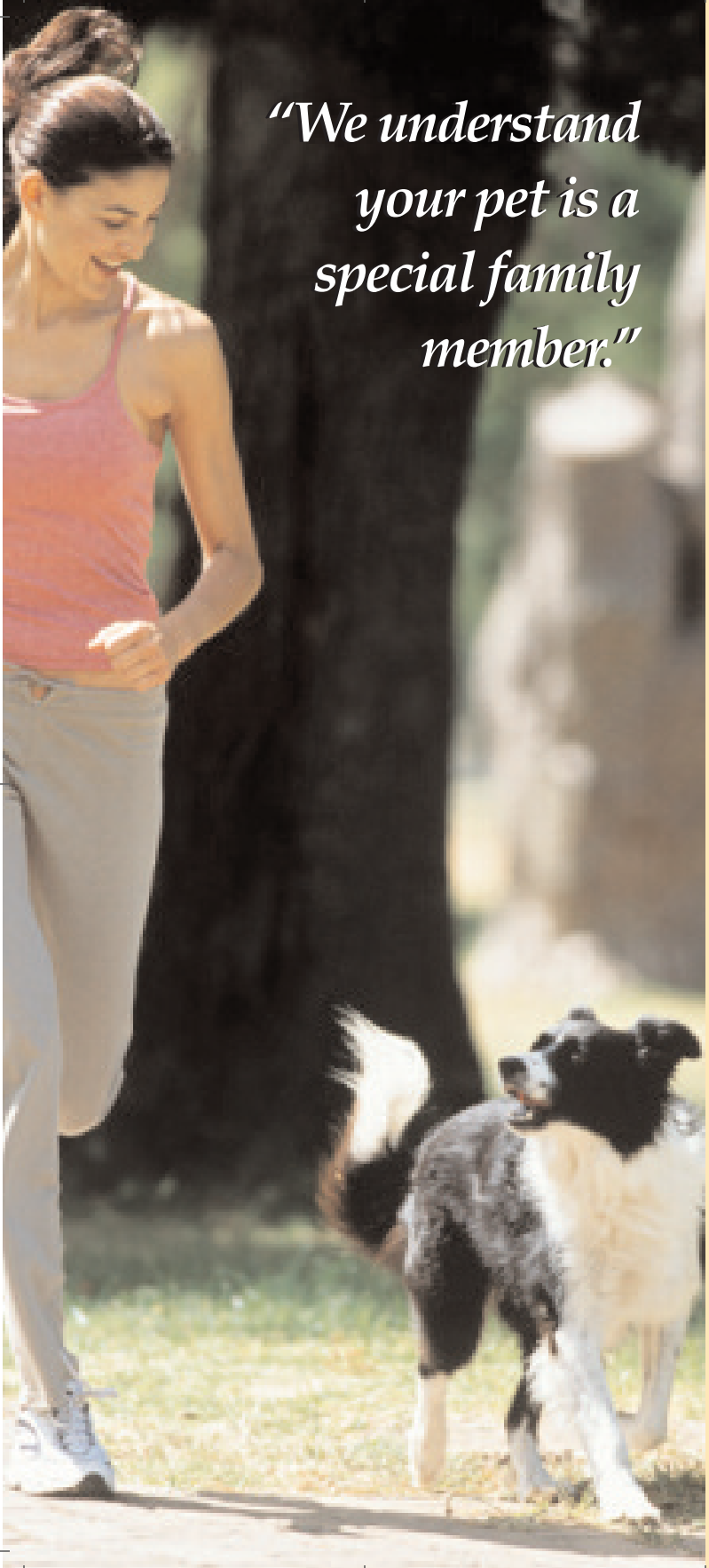

What specialized care does VHA have to offer?

To provide your pet with the best, our hospital offers specialized diagnostics, abdominal and cardiac ultrasound, spiral CT scan, digital radiology, endoscopy, bronchoscopy, chemotherapy, advanced orthopedic soft tissue surgery and a complete in-house laboratory. VHA's new state-of-the-art hospital accommodates critical patients requiring extended care. Our intensive care unit is staffed 24 hours and houses advanced equipment and critical care monitors. Our ICU cages are even heated to allow your pet to rest comfortably. To aid in recovery our pet rehabilitation center offers gentle healing in our underwater treadmill or with LASER light therapy.

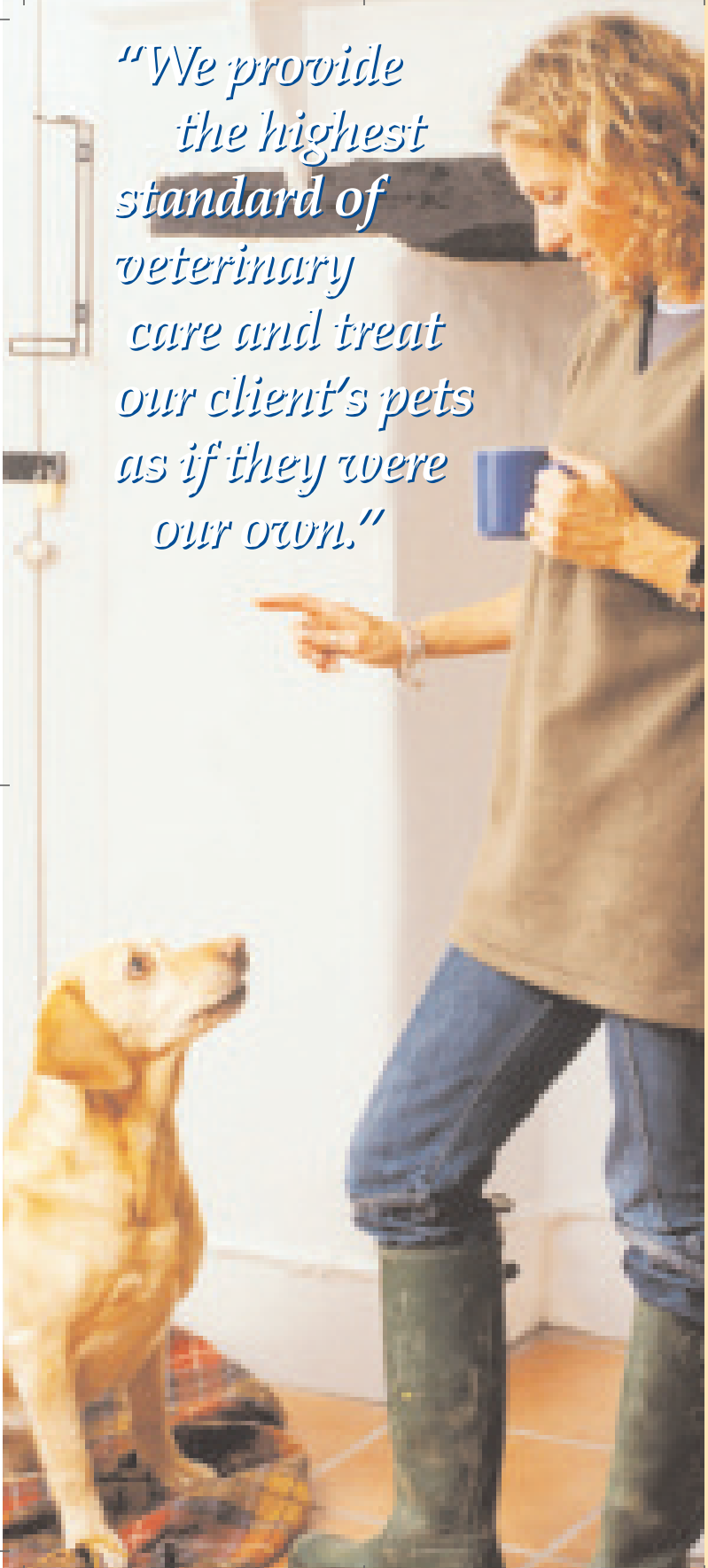
Questions & Answers

Why has my pet been referred to VHA?

Your family veterinarian has decided that your pet requires specialized treatment to help them get well. Our VHA doctors and staff will work closely with your regular veterinarian to provide the best care for your pet. Patients coming to VHA by referral or emergency will return to their family veterinarian when their treatment at VHA is complete. Continued care and follow-up treatment will be coordinated with your regular veterinarian if necessary. In order to maintain the trust that referring veterinarians have in us, VHA will not accept referred clients to our general practice.
